Advent Candles – The Advent wreath and candle lighting is a tradition originated in the Lutheran Church in Germany in the 1600s. It was brought to the United States in the 1930s. Originally, the candles stood as a marker of time until Christmas. Although the colors vary, we use three purple and one pink. It wasn't until more recently that the candles were given names. These names can

change but the focus of each should remind the congregation of the waiting period leading to Christmas. This year, we will be using names to reflect our church's themes this Advent season: anticipation, steadfastness, community, and love. The middle white candle always represents Christ's light coming into the world.
