

Bulletin Boards – To prepare for our guests on Christmas Eve, we are hoping to get all of our bulletin boards and information up to date. If your committee has a bulletin board, please stop by the church to see if it needs cleaned up.

Let's do a Shepherd's Run! – The shepherds were the first humans to tell the good news of Christ's birth. Advent Candles - The Advent wreath and candle lighting is a tradition originated in the Lutheran Church in Germany in the 1600s. It was brought to the United States in the 1930s. Originally, the candles stood as a marker of time until Christmas. Although the colors vary, we use three purple and one pink. It wasn't until more recently that the candles were given names. These names can

change but the focus of each should remind the congregation of the waiting period leading to Christmas. This year, we will be using names to reflect our church's themes this Advent season: anticipation, steadfastness, community, and love. The middle white candle always represents Christ's light coming into the world.

Wednesday Morning Bible Study – Starting January 5, we will read Beyond the Broken Heart: A Journey Through Grief. The first lesson will be very general; you will not need to have read anything beforehand. We meet at 10 am each Wednesday in the Resource Room or you can join us via the Vale Worship Zoom link. The book is available on Amazon (\$13.99 paper, \$9.99 kindle). You might be able to find a used copy as well.
