

White Doves – This year's White Dove Christmas drive to benefit Second Story was a huge success! Vale UMC collected – and delivered to our missions partner – 128 gift items worth over \$1,400. These included 7 sets of ear buds, 14 games, 18 sweatshirts, 14 sweatpants, 7 hairdryers, 2 cosmetic bags, 15 lipsticks, 8 nail polishes, 17 assorted other makeup items, 1 set of cozy socks, 12 movie passes, 1 AMC gift card and 10 gas cards. In addition to these physical gifts, 7 field trip sponsorships-worth \$210-and a \$100 donation were given by five generous people, bringing our White Dove campaign total to over \$1,700.
