

Vehicle Donation - Our friends at the Unitarian Universalist Congregation of Fairfax are seeking a used vehicle donation for an Afghan refugee family. As you know, many Afghan families recently fled their country



and are now settling in our greater DC area. UUCF is working through a non-profit called *Famil* to support one such family.

Six weeks into the project, with donated funds from the community, they have furnished a townhouse in Sterling for the family, helped with initial rent, utilities, and groceries, and located other resources such as school enrollment, health care, and English classes.

The family is currently dependent on volunteers for transportation to get to employment, shops, classes, and doctor's appointments. As they find jobs, having their own vehicle would be more practical.
